What are the Covid 9 symptoms? Symptoms of Covid 9 include:

- x Coldlike symptoms
  - o A stuffy nose
  - o A runny nose
  - o Sneezing
  - o A sore throat

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x If someone in the family or you live with has been diagnosed with Ct3v, ithe other family members need to go into quarantine for 10 days after the last unprotected contact with the Covid 19 diagnosed family member. After 10 days, if no one else hastsymspyour child can go back to school.

What if my child shows symptoms of Covit9 at school?

- x Pupils who Covid 9 symptoms visit the school nurse. We have the following procedure in place:
  - o The class teacher calls the nurse; the nurse will pick uptilide from class.
  - o The nurse assesses the child on the symptoms of C19vid
  - o The nurse evaluates whether the child needs to be sent home and contacts parents / guardians in that case.
  - o The nurse informs the class teacher and deputy that the child is **go log** picked up by the parents / guardian.
  - o Parents who come to school report to security at the main gate (head entrance) security will call the nurse that the parent / guardian is present.
  - o The child will wait for pickup in a seating section just oxide nurses station.
  - o The nurse will accompany the child to the main gate when the parent / guardian has arrived.

What if a teacher or a member of staff shows symptoms of CoVXV
